NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION DUES

During the October neighborhood meeting, members voted to raise annual dues to \$10 per adult in a household starting in 2023. Our neighborhood association is totally voluntary. We are not a HOA.

Your dues are used carefully to enhance the neighborhood. We host a spring clean-up replacing knock out roses, fertilizing and mulching them along with many common area trees and upkeep of the memorial park. We pay for electric and water for the front entrance. This past year our Winchester Road entrance has blossomed under the care of Barbara Hatton and Diane Gregory as they have added seasonal flowers and decorations. Holiday lighting has needed to be replaced. Upcoming plans are to repair the entrance wall and replace some dead trees. The entrance walls have historical significance as they are from the original farm entrance before the neighborhood moved from farmland to a neighborhood more than 60 years ago.
